

AGREEMENT AMENDING

THE PROTOCOL

ON

MUTUAL LEGAL ASSISTANCE

IN CRIMINAL MATTERS

PREAMBLE

We, the Heads of State or Government of:

The Republic of Angola

The Republic of Botswana

The Kingdom of Lesotho

The Republic of Mauritius

The Republic of Namibia

The Republic of South Africa

The Kingdom of Swaziland

The United Republic of Tanzania

The Republic of Zambia

The Republic of Zimbabwe

AWARE that the Protocol on Mutual Legal Assistance in Criminal Matters came into force March 1st, 2007;

CONVINCED that the Protocol on Mutual Legal Assistance in Criminal Matters is a contribution for the promotion and adoption of mutual assistance agreements and arrangements in criminal matters in the SADC Region;

BEARING in mind that the Protocol lacks provisions for a Region-wide institutional mechanism to follow up on the implementation and monitoring of the Protocol;

NOTING that there is need to establish a SADC institutional mechanism to oversee the implementation and monitoring of the Protocol;

HEREBY AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

ARTICLE 1 DEFINITIONS

In this Agreement, the terms and expressions defined in Article 1 of the Treaty and Article 1 of the Protocol on Mutual Legal Assistance in Criminal Matters shall bear the same meaning unless the context otherwise requires.

ARTICLE 2 AMENDMENT TO THE PROTOCOL ON MUTUAL LEGAL ASSISTANCE IN CRIMINAL MATTERS

The Protocol on Mutual Legal Assistance in Criminal Matters is amended by inserting, immediately after Article 22, the following Article 22A:

ARTICLE 22 A FUNCTIONAL INSTITUTION FOR IMPLEMENTATION AND MONITORING

State Parties hereby designate the Committee of Ministers of Justice/Attorneys-General to oversee the implementation of this Protocol in terms of their mandate provided for under Article 3(2) of the Protocol on Legal Affairs, 2000.

ARTICLE 3 ENTRY INTO FORCE

This Agreement shall enter into force on the date of its adoption by three-quarters of the States Parties to the Protocol.

ARTICLE 4 DEPOSITARY

- 1. The original texts of this Agreement shall be deposited with the Executive Secretary of SADC, who shall transmit certified copies to all Member States.
- 2. The Executive Secretary shall register this Agreement with the Secretariat of the United Nations Organisation and the Commission of the African Union.
