AGREEMENT

AMENDING THE PROTOCOL ON CORRUPTION

PREAMBLE

We, the Heads of State or Government of:

The Republic of Angola

The Republic of Botswana

The Democratic Republic of Congo

The Kingdom of Lesotho

The Republic of Madagascar

The Republic of Malawi

The Republic of Mauritius

The Republic of Mozambique

The Republic of Namibia

The Republic of the Sevchelles

The United Republic of Tanzania

The Republic of Zambia

The Republic of Zimbabwe

NOTING that the SADC Protocol Against Corruption (hereinafter referred to as the Protocol) entered into force on 6 July, 2005;

RECOGNISING that Article 11 of the Protocol makes provision for the establishment of a Committee for the implementation of the Protocol;

FURTHER RECOGNISING that there is a need to amend Article 11 of the Protocol to provide for the name of the Committee and to amend the reporting structure for the Committee;

HEREBY AGREE as follows:

ARTICLE 1 DEFINITIONS

In this Agreement, the terms and expressions defined in Article 1 of the Protocol shall bear the same meaning unless the context otherwise requires.

ARTICLE 2 AMENDMENT OF ARTICLE 1 OF THE PROTOCOL

Article 1 of the Protocl is amended by inserting in alphabetic order the following new definitions:

"Ministerial Committee of the Organ"

means the Ministerial Committee that is responsible for coordinating the work of the Organ as established in terms of Articles 3 and 5 of the SADC Protocol on Politics, Defence and Security Cooperation:

"SADC Anti Corruption Committee"

means the Committee established in terms of Article 11 to overseee the implementation of the Protocol.

ARTICLE 3 AMENDMENT OF ARTICLE 11 OF THE PROTOCOL

- 1. Paragraph 1 of Article 11 of the Protocol is amended to read as follows:
 - "1. A Committee consisting of State Parties is hereby established to oversee the implementation of this Protocol. The Committee shall be known as the SADC Anti Corruption Committee."
- 2. Paragraph 3(e) of Article 11 of the Protocol is amended to read as follows:
 - "3(e) Reporting to the Ministerial Committee of the Organ on the progress made by each State Party in complying with the provisions of this Protocol".

ARTICLE 4 ENTRY INTO FORCE

This Agreement shall enter into force on the date of its adoption by three-quarters of the Member States that are Parties to the Protocol.

ARTICLE 5 DEPOSITARY

- 1. The original texts of this Agreement shall be deposited with the Executive Secretary of SADC, who shall transmit certified copies to all Member States.
- 2. The Executive Secretary shall register this Agrement with the Secretariat of the United Nations Organisation and the Commission of the African Union.

Done at the Kingdom of Swaziland, this 31st day of August, 2016, in three (3) original texts in the English, French and Portuguese languages, all texts being equally authentic.
