


# SADC SELECTED ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL INDICATORS, 2015

## 1. Introduction

This report presents a snapshot of the socio-economic characteristics of SADC region for the Year 2015 based on Selected Economic and Social Indicators for the period 2006 to 2015. Data is primarily obtained from National Statistical Offices (NSOs) of SADC Member States and endorsed during the annual statutory meeting of SADC Statistics Committee (SSC), June 2016, Botswana. The core list of indicators depicting the region is presented in tables 1 to 20 and corresponds to data submission as at June 2016. The following sections present an analysis of trend of Gross Domestic Product (GDP), Trade and demographic statistics.

## 2. GDP

SADC region registered growth rate of 2.8% in 2015 compared to 3.3% in 2014 as illustrated in Figure 1. The Manufacturing sector, as identified as the key engine of growth in SADC for the coming decades, grew by 1.8% in 2015 compared to 1.3% in 2014. Post 2010, both overall GDP growth and manufacturing sector growth have been increasing on a decreasing trend up to 2015.



At country-specific level (Table 3), SADC economies that have registered growth rates above 7.0% are: DRC (7.7%) and Tanzania (7.0%) whilst Botswana registered negative growth of 0.3%. On the other hand, Zimbabwe, Seychelles, DRC and Mozambique registered significant growth in the manufacturing industry whereas Namibian and Angolan manufacturing sector declined by 7.1% and 2.2% respectively.

The share of manufacturing sector to overall GDP in 2015 worked out to 10.6%. However, since 2006, the SADC region has experienced constant decline of manufacturing share to GDP on an annual basis as illustrated in Figure 2 below. Manufacturing Sector represented 14.1% of SADC GDP in 2005, has gradually and constantly declined to reach 10.6% in 2015.





Figure 3 shows trend of nominal GDP per capita of SADC region for the period 2006-2015. GDP per capita stood at \$2067 in 2015 representing a significant decrease of 12.5% compared to \$2362 in 2014. Since 2006, this variable, as an important indicator of poverty, increased from \$1771 to \$2588, its highest level, in 2011. Post 2011, it has gradually decreased due to sharp depreciation of currencies of most SADC Member States. Table 4 shows the specific country GDP per capita where Seychelles has the highest whilst Malawi has the lowest per capita.
