AMCEN Special Session concludes with Bamako Declaration

At the Fourth Special Session of the African Ministerial Conference on the Environment (AMCEN) participants endorsed the African Common Position as the basis for negotiations at the upcoming UNFCCC COP17. The Special Session convened from 12-16 September 2011, in Bamako, Mali, to provide a platform for African countries to consolidate and enhance Africa's common negotiating position in the climate process. The Bamako Declaration stresses the need for the climate negotiations to produce two outcomes, namely the full, sustained implementation of the Convention, and a second commitment period for Annex 1 Parties under the Kyoto Protocol.
