- (c) Assist in the development of a Capacity Building Programme on COMESA, EAC and SADC Tripartite FTA ROO;
- (d) Training of stakeholders on COMESA, EAC and SADC Tripartite ROO.

The candidate should have:

- ➤ Education: The candidate must have a Post graduate qualification in the areas of Trade or Business Management.
- Experience: The successful candidate shall have at least 10 years Trade Policy work especially in Customs operations with special focus on Rules of Origin.
