	following area of specialization "in the field of investment policy harmonization, or financial market development and integration, or financial inclusion". This criterion could be understood in a way that a majority of companies who have a high experience and turnover in investment policy harmonization, financial market development and integration or financial inclusion projects but also implement consultancy in other technical domains could be excluded from the tender. Against this background, we would like to pose the following specific questions: i) Does this requirement refer to each of the submitted references or
