In line with the SADC Principles and Guidelines for Governing Democratic *Elections (2021)*, SADC has been invited by the Independent National Electoral Commission (CENI) of the Republic of Madagascar, to observe its First Round Presidential Election.

In accordance with the mandate of the Chairperson of the Organ on Politics, Defence and Security Cooperation as stipulated in the revised SADC Principles and Guidelines Governing Democratic Elections (2021), the Organ Chairperson, , Mr. Hakainde Hichilema, constituted the SADC Electoral Observation Mission (SEOM) to the Republic of Madagascar. The Chair of the Organ further appointed Brigadier General Godfrey Miyanda, Former Vice President of the Republic of Zambia, to lead the SADC Electoral Observation Mission (SEOM) to the Republic of Madagascar.

To this end, SADC will observe this First Round Presidential Elections, based on the adopted practice that supports Member States in ensuring regular and credible elections, namely the three-tier electoral observation approach that involves pre-election assessments, assessments during elections, and post-elections assessments, as enshrined in the SADC Principles and Guidelines Governing Democratic Elections.

SEOM began to arrive in Antananarivo, Republic of Madagascar, on 02 November 2023. As part of the preparations for this Mission and as is the norm, our observers underwent a refresher training from 06 to 09 November 2023, here in Antananarivo, which equipped them with the requisite skills to effectively observe, assess and report on the electoral process using Information and Communication Technologies (ICT). It is therefore encouraging that the Republic of Madagascar has allowed SADC to participate in this important process, which remains a cornerstone for the consolidation of democracy in the country and the SADC region.
